For a while now, we've been receiving reports from members that they've had issues with the way Shared Services' processing payments. As a result, we met with Shared Services to seek a resolution to the many issues that our members have raised with us over the past few months.

Immediate On Call Allowance

Following this meeting we took this opportunity to follow up concerns raised by our Radiology members regarding the implementation of the Immediate On call Allowance with the Executive Director of Shared Services, Mark Carey.

Radiographers would have seen an email about On Call Allowance sent by John Hristopoulos on 23rd May 2018. This email included communication from Management about what needs to be included on timesheets to enable Payroll Services to make payments.

Based on the current Immediate On Call status, we've received advice that all matters related to your worked hours and how you worked should be recorded on the time sheet, employees will be paid on the pay day applicably within their pay cycle (period 26th May to 8th June 2018 pending on your pay cycle).

Retrospective, payments of this allowance will be sorted separately, pending on further advice from the Office of the Public Sector.

We thank you for your patience and for your diligence in following up these matters.

Other Payroll Matters

We have been given a list of direct contacts for all issues regarding payroll. We have been asked to raise any individuals and collective issues regarding payroll directly with these contacts on our members' behalf.

If you have any outstanding payroll matters, you can forward your concerns to the HSU. In conjunction with Payroll Services and the LHNs, we will follow them up with Shared Service and the Local Health Networks; when required.
