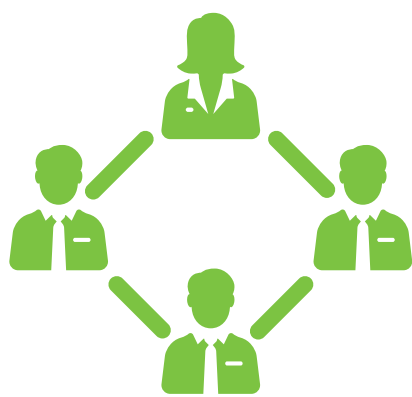


YOUR RIGHTS

UNDER THE WORK HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT (SA 2012)



UNDER SECTION 17:

An employer has a duty to provide a safe workplace, to eliminate and minimise health and safety risks



UNDER SECTION 19:

This duty of care extends to workers, or any other persons who may be put at risk by work being carried out (in this instance, it could be argued that this includes members of the public);



UNDER SECTION 28:

A worker has duties to take reasonable care of their own health and safety, and that of other persons. This means workers may need to initiate to self-isolate



UNDER SECTION 87:

An employer has an obligation to provide alternative suitable work if it is safe for the worker to do so



UNDER SECTION 47:

Employers should be consulting with members regarding any health and safety risks. Workers should have the opportunity to contribute to the decision making process, wherever possible.
